

Genetic Counseling

Advise patients or relatives at risk of an inherited disorder about the consequences of the disorder, the probability of developing or transmitting it, and the options open to them in management and family planning.

Draw blood for tests, transfusions, research, or blood donations. Some explain their work to patients and provide assistance when patients have adverse reactions after their blood is drawn.

Perform routine and complex lab tests to help with diagnosis and treatments.
