## SOCIAL WORKER

**B** **M** \$46,000

Social workers help people solve and cope with problems in their everyday lives. One group of social workers—clinical social workers—also diagnose and treat mental, behavioral, and emotional issues.



## HUMAN SERVICES PROFESSIONAL

**A** **B** \$37,000

"Human services professional" is a generic term for people who hold professional and paraprofessional jobs in such diverse settings as group homes and halfway houses; correctional, intellectual disability, and community mental health centers; family, child, and youth service agencies, and programs concerned with alcoholism, drug abuse, family violence, and aging.



## PSYCHOLOGIST

**M** **D** \$72,000

Psychologists study cognitive, emotional, and social processes and behavior by observing, interpreting, and recording how people relate to one another and their environments.



## PSYCHIATRIST

**D** \$165,000

A physician who specializes in the diagnosis and treatment of mental conditions.
