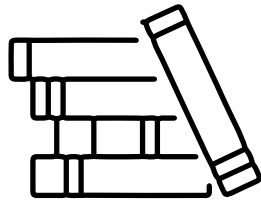


M**\$60,740****Health Science Librarian**

Biomechanist

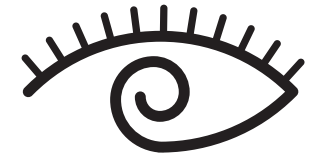
