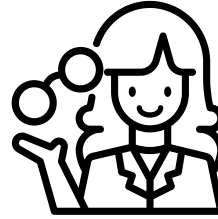

Optometrist

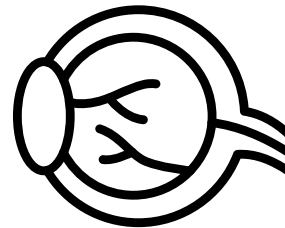
